KEEP YOUR EDUCATION ON TRACK

We are offering courses at all levels in January 2022. This includes GCSE, Pre-programme courses, the intensive 5-term A Level route, our fast-track 2-term University Foundation Programme (UFP). Students also have a unique opportunity to study the 2-term UFP on a Student Visitor Visa which does not require a SELT certificate.

Students can also benefit from starting the standard 6-term A Level and 3-term UFP courses in January. Typically offered in September, these courses have been restructured to run over the summer, keeping students on track to apply to university in September 2022 (UFP) or September 2023 (A Level).

GCSE

An internationally recognised qualification, the General Certificate of Secondary Education is a flexible two-year programme which provides a broad and solid secondary education.

A Levels

A Levels provides advance subject knowledge in preparation for final exams. Studying a minimum of three subjects, our courses feature additional English language support.

Pre-programme

Similar in approach to the GCSE but studied over one year or less, students can take GCSE exams in some subjects depending on the progress they make.

UFP

A pre-university qualification to bridge students' high school education in their own country to university in the UK. Develops English language and academic skills, while studying three subjects with exams at the end of the course and a significant amount of coursework which contributes to the final grade.
