

Evidence of your Finances for CHILD STUDENT visa



As part of your visa application the UKVI will assess whether you have sufficient funds to study in the UK. Your visa application must demonstrate that you have sufficient course and maintenance funds for your course of study, less any deposit paid:

If your CAS states	You are studying in London	You are studying outside of London
Boarding fees (example 1)	Course fees + accommodation fees	Course fees + accommodation fees
Course fees (example 2)	Course fees + £1,265 per month of studies (up to 9 months)	Course fees + £1,015 per month of studies (up to 9 months)

Date of statement

The bank statement must not be dated more than 31 days before the visa application date (which is associated with the payment of the visa application fee).

Your bank statement must be an original and not a scan, online printout or photocopy. It must feature an official bank logo and company or branch address.

Account name

You can use money held in an account belonging to you or your parent. If using the account held by your parent(s) you must provide evidence (for example a birth certificate) to prove you are related, and a financial consent letter, stating that their funds are available to use for your studies in the UK.

Example 1

You have applied for a 2-year A Level course at CATS College London and have requested college accommodation.

Boarding Fees (course + accommodation)

£29,985 + £19,995 = £49,980

Fees Paid

£2,500

You are required to show

£49,980 - £2,500 = £47,480

Example 2

You have applied for a 2-year A Level course at CATS College London and staying in independent (not college) accommodation.

Course Fees

£29,985

Maintenance Funds

£1,265 x 9 months = £11,385

Fees Paid

£2,500

You are required to show

(£29,985 + £11,385) - £2,500 = £38,870

Example 1

You have applied for a Foundation Diploma in Art & Design at CSVPA and have opted to stay in college accommodation.

Boarding Fees (course + accommodation)
£27,540 + £14,100 = £41,640

Fees Paid
£2,500

You are required to show
£41,640 - £2,500 = £39,140

Example 2

You have applied for a 2-year A Level course at CATS College London and will be staying in independent accommodation.

Course Fees
£29,985
Maintenance Funds
£1,265 * 9 months = £11,385

Fees Paid
£2,500

You are required to show
(£29,985 + £11,385) - £2,500 = £38,870

Example 3

You have applied for BA programme at CSVPA and have opted to stay in college accommodation.

Course Fees
£15,690
Accommodation Fees
£11,460

Fees Paid
£2,500

You are required to show
(£15,690 + £11,460) - £2,500 = £24,650
